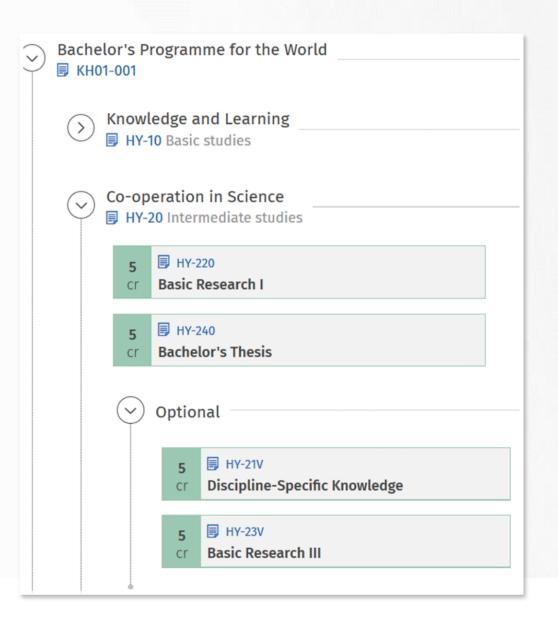

#### WHAT IS SISU?

- Sisu is a study information system implemented by the University of Helsinki in May 2021.
- In sisu you
  - prepare a study plan
  - register for courses
  - receive grades
  - fill in various applications.





## PRINCIPLES OF PLANNING STUDIES

- You do not need to prepare a study plan for your entire degree at once; you can flexibly edit it anytime.
- You do not usually need to send the plan to anyone for approval unless you
  want your degree to have a different structure or you want to add credits completed
  elsewhere to your plan. However, the study plan contains certain parts that need to
  be approved before you can graduate (in the plan they are marked as 'approval
  required')
- If necessary, you can have multiple study plans in Sisu, but only one of them can be the primary plan. You can only register for courses, fill in applications and graduate through your primary plan.
- Always register for courses through the study plan!
- It is a good idea to always update course version at the start of the academic year!

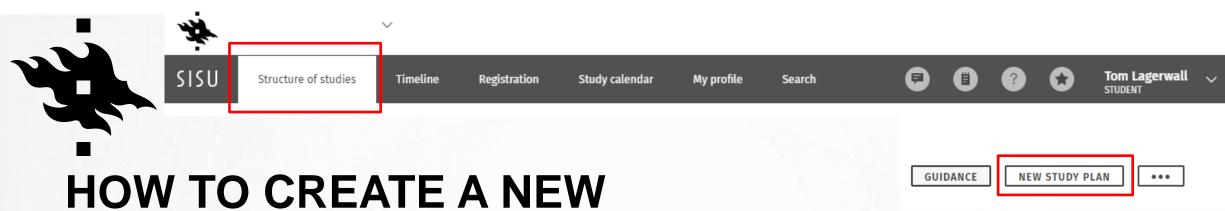

Register

- Check the studies required for your degree in Sisu or on the page <u>Structure and extent of</u> <u>degree</u>
- Learn about the courses available in the academic year: <u>studies.helsinki.fi/courses</u> or <u>https://studies.helsinki.fi/instructions/article/where-can-i-find-courses</u>
- Add the course to your primary plan if it is not already included.
- Select the completion method, i.e. whether you plan to complete the course by attending the classes or by taking the exam.
- On Sisu's Timeline page, select the timing of your studies in your degree.
- You can also use the timing template for your degree programme.

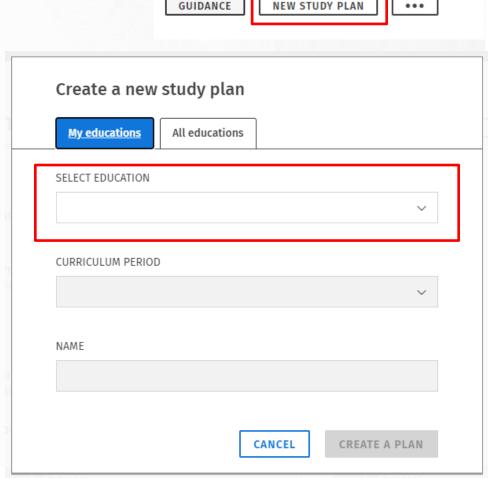
- Use Sisu's Study calendar to register when the enrolments open.
- There are specific criteria for being accepted for courses, which Sisu will check. In other words, enrolment is not all about being quick.

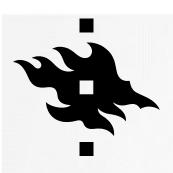


- 1. A study plan is created in the 'Structure of studies' –tab with the 'new study plan' button.
- 2. Choose on the 'My educations' –tab your education (you might see several if you have several study rights), the desired curriculum period (2023-2024) and finally give the plan a name.
- 3. 'Create a plan'

# ADDING THE STUDIES TO THE TIMELINE

- 1. Courses which have been added in the plan should be added to the timeline. This is a good way to estimate the planned amount of work in each period.
- 2. Some Programmes might have a timing template to help with the planning (on the left side of the screen).
- 3. Courses which have not been added can be found at the bottom of the screen.
- 4. Timing and duration of studies can be changed by clicking three dots on the course box (move the cursor on top of the course).

NB! It is possible to add courses to any period, so remember to check what kind of teaching is available in the planned period.

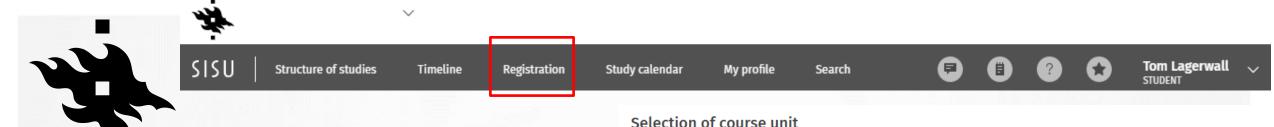

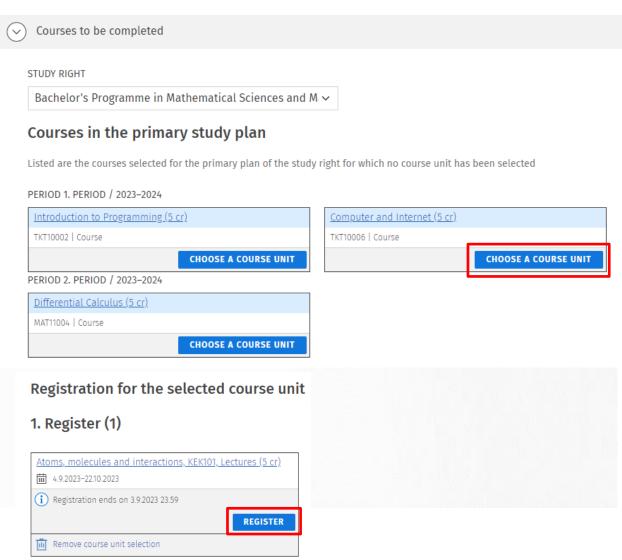

# HOW TO REGISTER FOR COURSES?

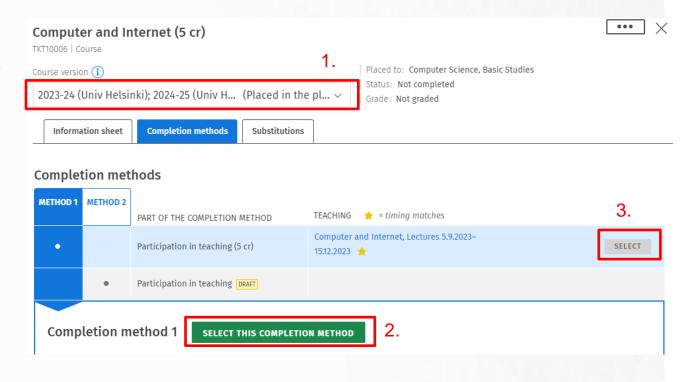
- 1. Add the course to the study plan and to the timeline (this way the course is easier to find in step 2).
- 2. Courses added to your study plan can be found on 'Registration'-tab:
  - First choose a course unit (i.e. method of completion and the teaching you want to register for)
  - Then register for teaching





## **CHOOSING THE COURSE UNIT**

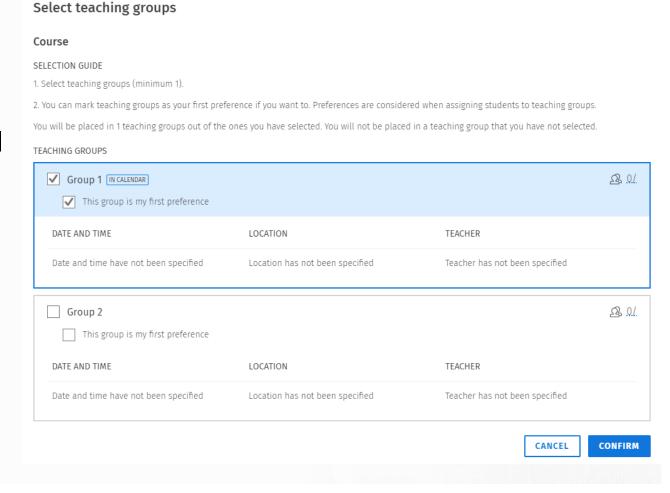
- 1. It's usually a good idea to update the version to the newest one available.
- 2. Choose the desired completion method; usually this is
  - 'Participation in teaching' ("normal lecture/laboratory course") or
  - 'Exam' (possibility to complete the course outside of normal teaching).
  - Remember to click on 'Select this completion method'!!!
- 3. Select the desired implementation/teaching.





#### REGISTERING FOR TEACHING AND EXAMS

- Confirm your registration and make possible group selections
- 2. Based on the selection criteria, you will be displayed a **tentative** confirmation on your registration (You can/cannot be chosen to the course...)
- The students accepted for the course unit are usually confirmed after the end of the registration period.
- Courses can also have a late registration period (after the actual registration period).





## **APPLICATIONS IN SISU**

In Sisu, you can apply for:

- approval of a diverging degree structure (free edit mode)
- credit transfer
- an extension to your study right
- separate approval requiring it (e.g. some study modules)
- Graduation

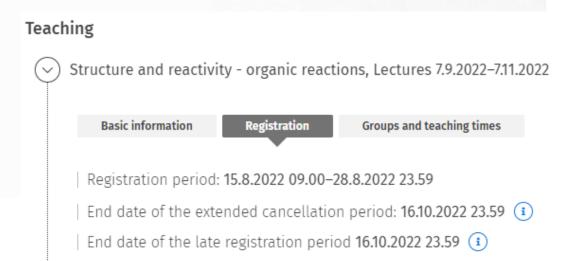
NB! All applications are done within the primary plan. If you create an entirely new plan, all applications/decisions must be made again!

If you copy an existing plan, previously made applications for it will also be copied.



## **EASY TROUBLESHOOTING (1)**

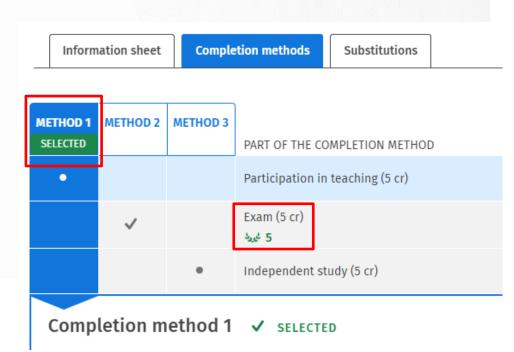
- If registration for course is rejected or not possible.
  - (Cancel the original registration and) try again after switching to the newest course version.
  - Have you registered through a course added to the study plan?!
  - Have you chosen a completion method or the correct completion method?
  - Registration is not possible if you already have a passing grade for the course.
  - Is the registration period open?
    - Open the course brochure -> Completion method -> click chosen 'Teaching' (info also at bottom of the page)





# **EASY TROUBLESHOOTING (2)**

- If a course is marked as partially completed on the transcript
  - Have you registered through a course added to the study plan?!
  - Have you completed all the required parts in the chosen completion method?
  - Check that the chosen completion method is correct
    - If the completion method differs, please correct it and wait overnight. If the situation has not been resolved after this, please contact the student services.
    - This can happen if e.g. you have completed the course as an exam, but you originally chose 'Participation in teaching'
